

Non-hazardous Waste Management in 2023

1) "WIB-WUB GreenBag2Tree"

On December 4th every year, which is Thai Environment Day, the company recognized the importance of managing waste within the company to minimize environmental impacts and transition towards "Zero Waste to Landfill". Therefore, the company organized activities for Thai Environment Day, encouraging employees to participate in collecting various product packaging waste, especially those that are not recyclable, to be donated to the "Smile Giving Snack" project. All proceeds from the project will be converted into donation funds for various child-related charities. Employees were instructed to neatly fold the snack/product packaging into the bags received from the activity, each with a code assigned to each employee. A plant will be awarded for every bag of collected packaging from each employee. The employee with the highest collected weight and the company branch with the highest collection proportion per employee will receive special rewards.

2) "Separate and Exchange for New"

The activity involves gathering leftover materials such as black and white paper, mixed paper, and paperboard to be sent to the "SCGP Recycle" project for recycling and value creation. Drop points have been set up in various areas of the company for employees to bring in their leftover materials and exchange them for products, such as A4 paper.
